

SGCI 2017 Conference Registration: Step by Step Instructions

Thank you for your interest in attending the 2017 SGCI Conference in Atlanta, GA! Online registration will have two phases: Early Bird which ends at midnight on January 15, 2017, and Regular which ends at midnight on February 26, 2017. You must be an active SGCI Member to register online; if you have a current membership, you should have an email with a special passcode. If you are not a current member, you will purchase your annual SGCI Membership during the registration process. Please see the following step-by-step instructions for more information. 1. Go to the registration portal site (etouches.com/sgci2017), and click the “New Registration” button to get started.



2. Enter your best email address at the top of the page. Select the category that best describes you. (Most individuals attending the conference will click “Conference Attendees.”) Press the “Continue” button.

Here is a description of the categories:

- **Awardees & Honorees**

This category is for the 2017 Award Recipients. The SGCI Awardees for the 2017 Conference include Lifetime Achievement: Sue Coe Printmaker; Emeritus: Sidney Cross; Excellence in Teaching: Norm Wagner ;Honorary Member of the Council: April Flanders Susan Goldman; Undergraduate Student Fellowship: TBD; Graduate Student Fellowship: TBD. You must have a special passcode to register in this category.

- **Conference Presenters**

This category is for the 2017 Conference Presenters including Panel Chairs and Panelists, Themed Portfolio Organizers, Demonstrators, and INKubation/Conference Paper facilitators. You must have a special passcode to register in this category.

- **Conference Attendees**

This is the category for most conference-goers! Select this if you are attending the full conference or a single day of the conference.

- **Volunteers**

SGCI Members who volunteer 20 hours before, during and/or after the conference will receive a conference fee waiver for their service. (All volunteers must already be members in good standing, or purchase/renew an annual SGCI Membership.) Please contact 2017 Conference Volunteer Coordinator Kathy Garrou to fill out the volunteer form and receive the password to register in this category: aps.director@gmail.com.

- **Vendors, Publishers & Programs**

Individuals & Groups who wish to take part in the SGCI 2017 Conference Vendor/Publisher/Program Fair, consisting of the following categories: Publishers: Disseminators of all things print or printmaking-related; Programs: Organizations and Institutions nurturing all things print and printmaking-related; Vendors: Purveyors of all things print and printmaking-related . Select your level on a first come, first-served basis. The levels include the following: Level 1: 1 Table + 1 Full Conference Registration Level 2: 2 Tables + 2 Full Conference Registrations Level 3: 3 Tables + 2 Full Conference Registrations.

- **Catalog Advertising**

Individuals, organizations, companies and programs interested in purchasing ad space in the SGCI 2017 Conference Catalog can choose this option. This does not include SGCI Membership or registration, just advertising options.

- **SGCI Employees & Conference Steering Committee**

SGCI Staff and 2017 Atlanta Conference Steering Committee Members choose this option to register. You must have a special passcode to register in this category.

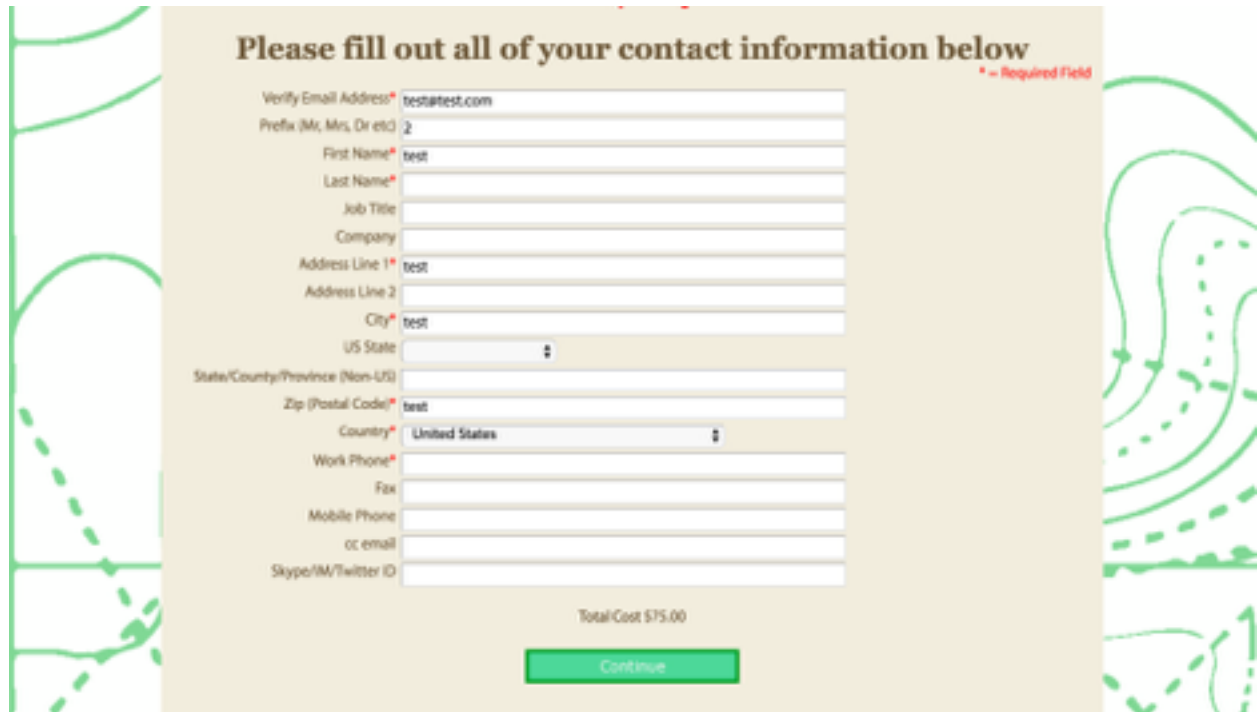
